BALBOA THEATRE

THE HISTORIC BALBOA THEATRE ORIGINALLY OPENED IN 1924 as a premiere vaudeville house before being converted to films in the 1930's. In the 1980's, it was acquired by the City's Redevelopment Agency and was closed for approximately 20 years. In January 2008, the historic Balboa Theatre reopened as a performing arts venue after a \$26 million restoration and renovation by the Redevelopment Agency. The project restored the historic finishes and appearance of the Theatre while incorporating current audience and production expectations to ensure its use for generations to come. With 1,339 seats, the historic Balboa Theatre provides exceptional sightlines for audiences. Its ornate finishes provide a uniquely dramatic and exciting venue for experiencing all types of entertainment for corporate, convention and private gatherings. With its location in the heart of the Gaslamp Quarter, the Balboa Theatre is conveniently located near downtown hotels, dining and nightlife opportunities.

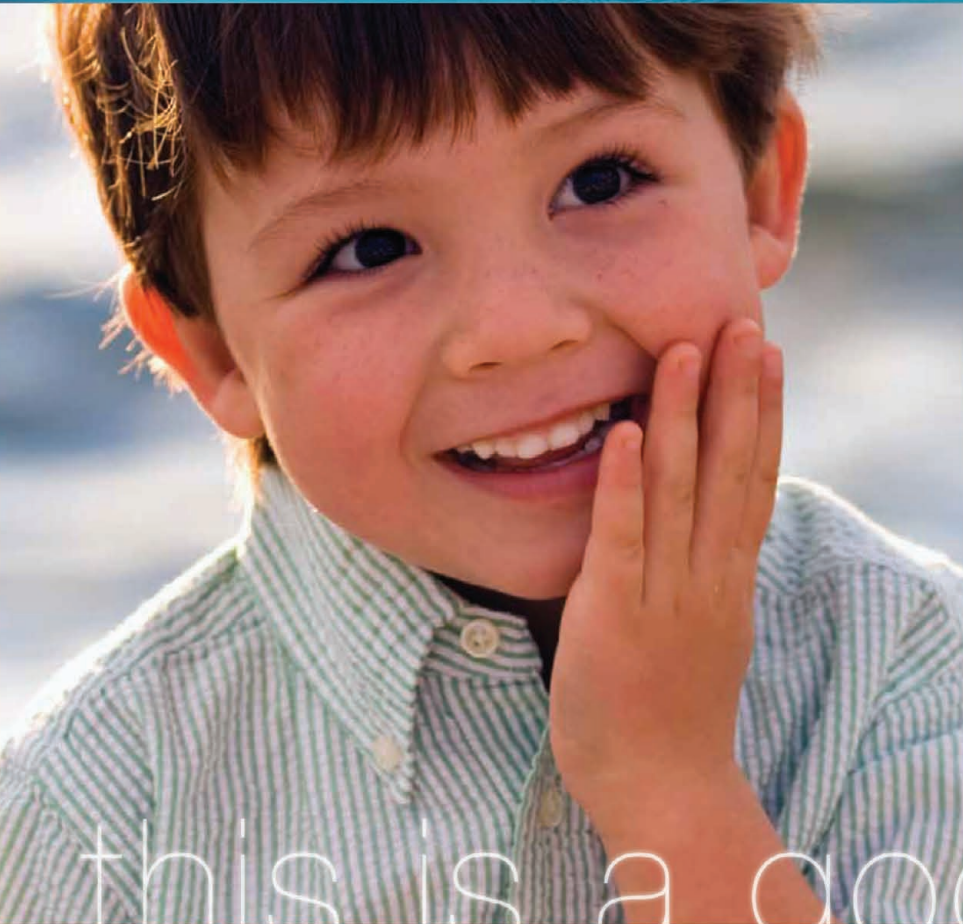
