Plan your route

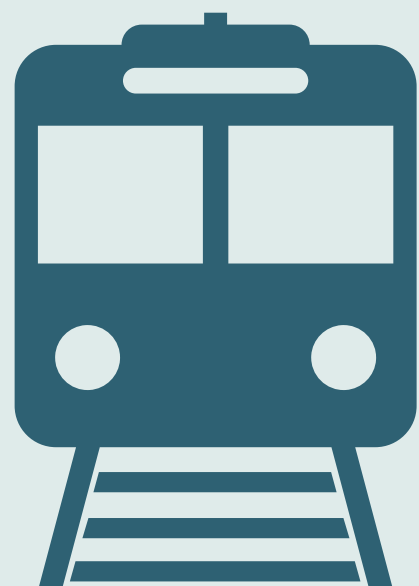
Prepare for your ride ahead of time by planning your route. Knowing where you are going and familiarizing yourself with your route is the best way to ready yourself for your journey. The Google Maps App allows users to view public transportation options and plan the best routes.

Purchase a pass

Purchase your pass at ticket vending machines or in the PRONTO San Diego app. Be sure to tap your pass on a validator prior to boarding the Trolley.

Hold on

Sit or stand anywhere you'd like but be sure to hold on to the railing or handholds.



Etiquette tips

- Let people off before you board!
- Be mindful to reserve the spaces marked for senior and disabled riders.

Find your Trolley stop

Plan to arrive at your stop a few minutes ahead of the time listed on the schedule.

Riding the Trolley

Be prepared to show fare inspectors your activated fare either on the platform before your ride or while your on board.

Be sure to check that you have all of your belongings before leaving the Trolley.
